

Instructions

<u>GOAL</u>

To answer four questions in the positive, making it to the FINISH. You have 3 strikes (chances) to make it to the FINISH.

HOW TO PLAY

- 1. Make pairs.
- 2. Janken to decide who answers the questions (janken winner, SI) and who asks the questions (janken loser, S2).
- 3. S2 asks their question, e.g. "May I have some curry?".
- 4. The students janken again.
- 5. If SI wins, they answer the affirmative answer (white box) and then move to the next question. S2 asks the next question.
- 6. If SI loses, they answer the negative answer (black box) and go back to the start. They also mark off a "strike". S2 asks the first question again and SI attempts to reach the FINISH.
- 7. For SI to reach the finish, they must therefore win 4 janken matches in a row to get the affirmative answers.
- 8. Once finished (SI wins or strikes out), change partners. Repeat from step 1.

<u>NOTES</u>

If SI loses a janken, they must answer the negative answer and GO BACK TO THE VERY START (not just back one level).
