















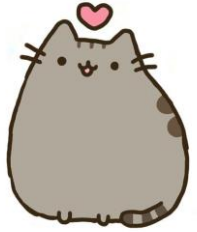

What restaurant should they go to?</p> <p> Let Pusheen's mother <u>choose</u> the restaurant. → Go to card 8 Pusheen helped her mother choose the restaurant. → Go to card 9</p> <p>選ぶ </p>	<p>(5) It's time for Pusheen to go to school. When she <u>arrives</u> at school she sees a smartphone. Someone lost their phone! What should she do?!</p> <p> Make Pusheen leave the phone <u>where it is</u>. → Go to card 10 Pusheen helped by bringing the phone to the teachers room. → Go to card 11</p> <p>着く ある場所に</p>	<p>(6) Pusheen is already late for school, but she sees a bird <u>stuck</u> in a <u>ditch</u>!
